



Jun Lu, MD

Dr. Lu graduated from China Medical University and finished residency and postdoc research training at Mayo Clinic, Rochester MN. She joined Department of dermatology, University of Connecticut as a faculty since 2010 after residency. Dr. Lu practice general dermatology, specializing in complicated medical dermatology including autoimmune bullous disease and autoimmune connective tissue disease. Dr. Lu is the director of clinical research and clinical trial unit of Uconn dermatology. She's the principle investigator of multiple clinical trials and clinical studies on new therapies for inflammatory skin disorders including bullous pemphigoid.



Jeff Gehlhausen, MD

Dr. Gehlhausen, is a dermatologist and clinical instructor at the Yale Department of Dermatology. Dr. Gehlhausen did his medical school at Indiana University School of Medicine; Indianapolis, IN, his internship in internal medicine at Vanderbilt University, and he completed his clinical dermatology training at Yale University where he served as a chief resident. During his residency, he obtained significant additional clinical training in the management of complex autoimmune disorders like lupus erythematosus and dermatomyositis at Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston, MA.

Dr. Gehlhausen is a scientist with training in biochemistry, molecular biology, and immunology. He has an interest often hard-to-diagnose autoimmune skin diseases that can be very challenging to treat. One of his research passions is lupus erythematosus and other autoimmune diseases. Dr. Gehlhausen also is very engaged in academics and medical education in the Yale Dermatology program, working with both medical students and Dermatology residents. He has authored multiple Dermatology textbook chapters.



Omar Ibrahimi, MD, PhD

Dr. Omar Ibrahimi is the medical director of the Connecticut Skin Institute. He completed his Dermatology training at Harvard Medical School and a fellowship program in Mohs and Reconstructive Surgery, Laser and Cosmetic Surgery at the University of California – Davis. He is well known nationally having been an invited speaker at numerous national meetings, and written extensively about Mohs Surgery, Laser and Cosmetic Procedures. Dr. Ibrahimi has published over 65 research articles and book chapters on skin cancer surgery, laser and cosmetic procedures in leading medical journals. He has also performed thousands of cases of Mohs Surgery and Laser and Cosmetic procedures. Dr. Ibrahimi previously served as a Visiting Assistant Professor of Dermatology at Harvard Medical School in the Wellman Center for Photomedicine. The Wellman Center for Photomedicine is the world's leading research center where the majority of today's laser and cosmetic technologies were invented and tested. He is an active participant in many clinical trials of new technologies.
